## ENTRY INFORMATION:

**Closing date for entries: Friday, May 16, 2008**

1. The Fairgrounds is imposing a fee for disposal of stall bedding, we will have to charge the exhibitors a fee of \$10.00 per horse in addition to your stall fee. Sorry! Stalls and tack rooms will be \$70.00 each, plus \$10.00 per horse. Stalls will be assigned upon a receipt of paid entry. Most of the stalls have had stall mats installed.
2. For insurance purposes, all horses exhibited must have a stall. There will be **no working out of trailers.**
3. Entries must be postmarked and by the closing date or there will be a **\$20.00 fee per entry.** Payment must be included with entry to cover all stalls and one class per entry. Payment may be made in full, or for stalls and one class, or with a signed (blank amount) check, made payable to **Tennessee Saturday Night Show**, which will be kept on file until the end of the show. There will also be a **\$20.00 office fee.** Show numbers will not be issued until payment is made and entry is complete.
4. **The Show Office will be checking Registration Papers on all horses shown at this show...so bring your papers.** If papers are mailed in with entry form, please make sure that both sides of the papers are copied, so that the registered owner's name is shown, besides the registered name and number of the horse. All horses must be registered with the TWHBEA and must be entered under their registered name, and the registered owner's name. If the horse is being leased, please bring your lease agreement.
5. Current amateur cards (AHSA, NHSC, WIWHA, WSH or WHOA) must be presented by all amateur participants, and WIWHA Youth cards must be presented by all juvenile participants. Juvenile exhibitors must be 17 years or younger as of December 31, 2005. WIWHA Amateur cards are \$20.00, WIWHA Youth cards are free, and both will be available at the Show Office.
6. The trainer of the horse must sign all entries. If you do your own training, sign as the trainer.
7. To receive Pre-entry refunds, a copy of the Veterinarian's certificate specifying exact nature of disability, accompanied by the Veterinarian's bill for treatment. Fees not refunded will be \$30.00.
8. The listed stall and tack room fee covers Friday 7AM through Monday noon. The fairgrounds will open at 7:00 AM Friday morning. Stalls will be assigned by the show committee. **Early/Day stall fees are \$30.00 per day.**
9. Persons failing to pay their bills at the show will be charged a **\$30.00 service fee.** If the account is not settled after billing, it will be reported to WIWHA for collection. If not resolved, suspension will result and names will also be sent to the NHSC. Those on suspension will not be allowed to show at WIWHA or NHSC affiliated shows. A **\$30.00 service charge** will be assessed for any NSF checks.
10. **Grounds fees must be Pre-Paid** for every motor home, camper or horse trailer that is used as sleeping accommodations.
11. Please list **all** riders for horse on the entry form. Additional spaces are provided on back of form.

## CLASS INFORMATION:

1. All classes will be conducted by the rules of the WIWHA/NHSC Rulebook and the TWHBEA Versatility Rulebook. For specific rules or class descriptions, please refer to the WIWHA/NHSC Rulebook and the TWHBEA Versatility Rulebook, which will be for sale at the show office.
2. **Management has the right to cancel or combine any class that has less than three (3) horses entered.**
3. **All classes must be entered before the end of the session prior to the session in which the class appears to qualify for the listed class fee.**
4. Gate holds (3 minutes maximum) will be granted for just cause upon notification of the In-Gate announcer.
5. To qualify for a Championship class, a horse must have been shown and judged in a comparable gait class in its division (i.e. 3 gait qualifying class / 3 gait Championship; 2 gait qualifying class / 2 gait Championship). A Juvenile must show their horse in the Juvenile qualifying class to be eligible for the TWH Juvenile Championship class.
6. The same horse/rider combination may **NOT** enter both a 2 gait and a 3 gait Championship.
7. **Trail Pleasure Classes are Amateur Only. Trail Pleasure horses are not allowed to show in any other Lite Shod or Plantation classes at the same show, but they are eligible to show in halter and versatility classes (TWH PLEASURE, Obstacle Trail, and Water Glass) at the same show.**
8. **TWH PLEASURE HORSE CLASSES are open to Plantation, Lite Shod and Trail and Country Pleasure horses.**
9. **Novice** – not to have won 3 blue ribbons in any affiliated show. **Maiden** – not to have any blues in any affiliated show. **Amateur Owned and Trained (AOT)** – For horses that have not been in training for 90 days immediately preceding the show. **Ladies to Ride and Gentlemen to Ride** – Exhibitors must have an amateur card and be 18 years or older, no cross entry with juvenile classes. **Per the new NHSC rules Stallions are allowed in Ladies to Ride classes.**  
**No Stallions are allowed in Juvenile classes.**  
**If the TWH Pleasure Class does not list English or Western you may show in either tack.**
12. **"Park Performance"** - a performance division class which will be limited to a maximum size shoe of one and a half inches by half and inch with a one inch turn back, with bands optional. A maximum one inch pad measured at the heel and an action device of a maximum of six ounces. Braced tails and rock back pads are prohibited. **May cross enter in the show pleasure classes?**

## POINTS:

1. Tennessee Saturday Night Qualifies for Pacific Northwest Regional Highpoints.

## USDA RULES:

1. If exhibitors plan to stay in the warm up arena for more than one class, they must check in with the DQP Secretary prior to each class.
2. No chains on plantation, lite shod or trail pleasure horses on the show grounds.
3. No horse will be allowed in the warm-up ring or checked through the DQP station more than 3 classes ahead of the class in which it is entered.
4. Only one handler per horse will be allowed in the DQP station. This will be enforced.

## FAIRGROUND RULES:

1. Exhibitors and show personnel should be advised to keep their children under control at all times. Since there are many areas on the grounds that are under construction or generally unsafe, children caught wandering away from event areas will be returned to their parent or guardian on the first offense. On the second offense, children and parent will be asked to leave the grounds.
2. With the exception of seeing-eye dogs, **dogs will not be allowed on the grounds.** Dogs kept by RV users must be kept on a leash or in a pen near the applicable RV.
3. **No horses are allowed on the North side, or "front", of the barns, not even for unloading.**
4. **All manure on the South side of the barns including the wash racks must be picked up and disposed of properly. All manure and shavings that come out of trailers when unloading must be cleaned up.**
5. No riding of horses, motorcycles or bicycles in barns. Keep horses in barn areas and specific warm-up areas only. Observe the grounds 10-MPH speed limit at all times. No lunging of horses in the main show ring. Use warm-up arena for this.
6. **Unlicensed drivers are not permitted to drive any motorized vehicles on Fair property.**
7. The following items will not be tolerated per the Fairgrounds and Show Committee:

- VANDALISM that may cause harm to the grounds, exhibitors, spectators or horses (you will be requested to leave).
- NAILING of any type into the interior or exterior of any building areas.
- DRILLING OF HOLES in walls, stalls, etc.
- CHANGES TO THE ELECTRICAL SYSTEM.
- PAINTING OF HORSES HOOVES ON UNPROTECTED CONCRETE AREAS.
- STRUCTURES ALTERED IN ANY WAY.
- STAPLES LEFT IN THE WALLS. (If you hang drapes, you may use staples, but the staples must be removed totally when removing drapes, etc.)

We expect you to leave the Fairgrounds in the same condition as you find it. Therefore, you will be held financially responsible for any damage.

8. **All display drapes must be sprayed with a fire retardant per the Puyallup Fire Department. They will be conducting spot checks of the drapes. They also complained about plugged-in appliances last year.**
9. If shavings, bark or landscaping materials are used outside your barn area, all of these materials must be removed and the area swept clean.

## GENERAL INFORMATION:

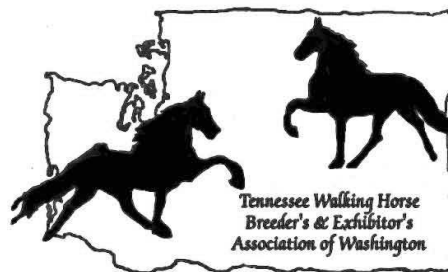
1.
